Any coin determined inauthentic by a recognized authority or professional numismatist may be returned at any time for a complete refund.

Coins found to be substantially misdescribed based on the state of scholarship *at the time of sale* may be returned at any time for a complete refund of purchase.

Authentication fees will be reimbursed if a coin is found to be a modern forgery (this does not include "unable to authenticate" or "authenticity unverifiable" or other finding besides modern forgery).

30 Day Approval Period. Items are considered "sold on approval" for 30 days and may be returned for a refund with no reason required, regardless of authenticity.

ALL returns must be in original, unaltered condition.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY (Photographs, descriptions, and records):

Photographs and records of sales will be maintained at seller's discretion & will be made reasonably available for verification in the future, to the best of seller's ability.
